



Permit to remediate friable asbestos contamination in Lawson, ACT

PERMIT E2023/0223

This decision is made under section 201 of the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (EPBC Act).

Part A - Conditions attached to the permit

Note: Words appearing in bold have the meaning assigned to them at Part B - Definitions

DISTURBANCE LIMITS

- 1) To avoid and mitigate **harm to protected matters**, in taking the Action, the permit holder must not **clear**:
 - a) outside the **Action area**.
 - b) more than 0.055 hectares of **Natural Temperate Grassland**.

SOIL SCRAPING

- 2) To mitigate **harm to protected matters** as a result of **soil scraping**, in taking the **Action**, the permit holder must:
 - a) not undertake **soil scraping** outside of the **Action area**.
 - b) ensure that no **soil scraping** activities exceed a depth of 100mm below the soil surface.
 - c) only undertake **soil scraping** in accordance with the method described in the **permit application**.
- 3) To mitigate **harm to protected matters**, the permit holder must engage a **suitably qualified field ecologist** to monitor works and provide guidance on how to minimise **harm to protected matters** prior to and during **soil scraping**.

STRIPED LEGLESS LIZARD MITIGATION

- 4) To limit harm to **Striped Legless Lizard**, if any **Striped Legless Lizard** individual is found within the **Action area**, the permit holder must:
 - a) Immediately cease all works for the Action in the vicinity.
 - b) Ensure:
 - i) the Striped Legless Lizard individual vacates the Action area of their own accord, or
 - ii) a suitably qualified field ecologist captures and safely relocates the Striped Legless Lizard individual as specified in the permit application.
 - c) Not recommence works for the Action unless all **Striped Legless Lizard** individuals have safely vacated the **Action area** and the vicinity.

REVEGETATION

- 5) To mitigate **harm to protected matters**, the permit holder must:
 - a) Notify the **department** of the date which all **asbestos remediation works** have been completed.
 - b) Commence revegetation of all **cleared Natural Temperate Grassland** within 3 months following the completion of all **asbestos remediation works**.
 - c) Ensure the revegetation of the **cleared Natural Temperate Grassland** is not inconsistent with the requirements of the **NTG criteria**.

ADMINISTRATION

6) The permit holder may give to another person written authority to take, for or on behalf of the permit holder, any activity authorised by the permit. When an authority is given to another person, these permit conditions also apply. The giving of an authority to another person does not prevent the permit holder from undertaking the authorised activity. The permit holder who gives an authority to another person must inform the **department** in writing within 14 days after giving the authority. The permit holder may only give an authority to another person who has sufficient experience and competence in the activities of this permit.

Note: The permit holder remains the party responsible for compliance with the conditions of this permit.

7) By 30 September 2024 and annually thereafter for the duration of the permit, the permit holder must submit to the department an interim **compliance report** which addresses how the permit conditions have been complied with.

8) The permit holder must publish all **compliance reports** on their **website** within 10 **business days** of providing them to the **department**. The permit holder must ensure each **compliance report** remains published for a minimum of 12 months.

9) The permit holder must publish the approved permit on their **website** for the duration that the permit has been approved.

Part B - Definitions

In these conditions any bolded use of a word or term refers to the below definition of that word or term:

Action area means the location of the Action, represented in Attachment A by the zones shaded red and designated 'Soil Scrape Area'.

Asbestos means the asbestiform varieties of mineral silicates belonging to the serpentine or amphibole groups of rock forming minerals including actinolite asbestos, grunerite (or amosite) asbestos, anthophyllite asbestos, chrysotile asbestos, crocidolite asbestos, and tremolite asbestos.

Asbestos remediation works means the activities to remediate friable asbestos from within the Action area in accordance with this permit.

Business day means a day that is not a Saturday, a Sunday, or a public holiday in the Australian Capital Territory.

Clear, clearing or cleared means the cutting down, felling, thinning, logging, removing, killing, destroying, poisoning, ringbarking, uprooting, or burning of vegetation.

Commencement of the Action means the date on which the first instance of any activity associated with the Action (including **clearing**) is undertaken.

Compliance report means a written report which:

- 1) provides accurate and complete details demonstrating compliance and any non-compliance with all conditions of this permit, and
- 2) is consistent with the *Annual Compliance Report Guidelines*, Commonwealth of Australia 2014.

Department means the Australian Government agency responsible for the administering the **EPBC Act**.

EPBC Act means the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999 (Cth)*.

Golden Sun Moth means the **EPBC Act** listed threatened species *Synemon plana*.

Harm means to cause any measurable direct or indirect disturbance or deleterious change as a result of any activity associated with the Action.

Natural Temperate Grassland means the **EPBC Act** listed ecological community Natural Temperate Grassland of the South Eastern Highlands.

NTG criteria means the description of the ecological community, key diagnostic criteria and conditions thresholds specific to the Natural Temperate Grassland, as described in *Approved Conservation Advice (including listing advice) for the Natural Temperate Grassland of the South Eastern Highlands (EC 152)*, Commonwealth of Australia 2016.

Own accord means to do something without being forced or otherwise persuaded. ■

OFFICIAL

Permit application means the **EPBC Act** Part 13 permit application for permit reference number E2023/0223, including all attachments to the permit application.

Protected matter means a matter protected under a controlling provision in Part 3 of the **EPBC Act** for which this permit has effect. **Protected matters** include:

- 3) **Golden Sun Moth,**
- 4) **Striped Legless Lizard,** and
- 5) **Natural Temperate Grassland.**

Soil scraping means the removal of the top layer of earth by scraping the surface of the soil.

Striped Legless Lizard means the **EPBC Act** listed threatened species *Delma impar*.

Suitably qualified field ecologist means a person who has relevant professional qualifications and at least 3 years of work experience designing and implementing surveys for **Natural Temperate Grassland, Golden Sun Moth** and **Striped Legless Lizard**, and can give an authoritative assessment and advice on the presence of said species and communities using relevant protocols, standards, methods and/or literature.

Website means a set of related web pages located under a single domain name attributed to the permit holder and available to the public.
